Pre-Entry Fees: Flat Fee \$75.00/animal for the entire show **OR** \$20.00/class (Postmarked by May 9)

Post Entry Fees: Flat Fee \$85.00/animal for the entire show **OR** \$25.00/class (Postmarked after May 9)

Stall Fee: \$45.00 per stall (includes 1 bag shavings) - **NO JUMP OUTS** per Facility. All animals must be stalled.

Camping: \$15.00 per day

Shavings: \$8.00 per bag - No outside bedding allowed per facility!

Office Fee: \$8.00 per animal

New for 2011: All exhibitors will be asked to leave a check with the Show Office, which will be returned at check-out if no additional fees have been incurred.

Send completed entry form and copy of ASPC or AMHR Registration Certificate for each horse/pony. Please copy front and back (if needed) to verify current owner/lessee. **Gelding status must be reflected on the registration certificate for the horse/pony to be shown in a Gelding class!** Exhibitors may choose to pay entry fees either per class **OR** per horse/pony for the entire show. A horse/pony may be entered in all classes for which it is qualified for the flat fee. Entries must be postmarked by May 9, 2011, to avoid post entry fees. Horses/Ponies entered after May 9 will be charged the post entry fee. **All monies and registration certificate copies must accompany entries. Entries received without payment will not be accepted until payment is received, thus being subject to the post entry fee instead of the normal fee.** Previously entered ponies may enter additional classes at the show with no penalty.

Measuring: The ASPC/AMHR Steward will be available Friday from 3:00-7:00 pm and Saturday & Sunday as needed to measure ponies/horses. Ponies/horses with Permanent measurement cards and those with Annual measurement cards, updated within the last 60 days, will **not** be required to measure. Foals will be measured if they do not have a current annual card. **ALL EXHIBITORS MUST CHECK IN WITH THE STEWARD BEFORE SHOW PACKETS WILL BE GIVEN OUT** - bring animal (if needed), registration papers (or photocopy) to measurement location. **PAPERS MUST MATCH ENTRIES.** When finished with the Steward, take your signed measurement forms to the show office to obtain your show packet. **NONE WILL BE GIVEN OUT WITHOUT PROOF OF MEASUREMENT.**

Championship/Stake Classes: Performance Championship/Stake classes must be pre-entered and require an entry fee. Your horse/pony must have also competed in one of the qualifying classes to be eligible for the Championship/Stake class. See the ASPC/AMHR rule book for qualifying classes.

Health Requirements: All out of state horses/ponies must have a negative Coggins test within 365 days and a valid Health Certificate. Foals under 6 months of age are exempt from Coggins test requirements if accompanied

by negative tested dam. The Area VI SP&MHBA reserves the right to ask for an on-site Veterinary inspection, at the owner's expense, for any animal appearing to be in poor health.

Two Minute Gate Call: The two minute gate call will be strictly enforced No refunds will be given for missed classes.

Tack Changes: A 5 minute tack change must be requested at the in-gate at least one class prior to the class where the tack change is needed.

Entry Refunds: A refund will be given only with a signed veterinary certificate stating the horse/ponies illness/injury. **The certificate must be given to the show manager at time of check in.** The refund will be for the entry fee(s) for that horse/pony only and will not include any other fees. Stall fees are non-refundable. **Exhibitors that do not check in or choose not to show healthy horses will not have any fees refunded!**

Sessions: Each place in the show schedule where a blank line appears denotes the end of one session and the beginning of the next session.

Adds/Scratches: All class adds and scratches must be done prior to the start of the session the class is scheduled in, or 10 classes prior if in the first ten classes of the session.

Stall information: No more than two animals are allowed per stall. Stall fees will include one bag of shavings. Additional bedding must be purchased from facility, and will be available for purchase on the grounds. Prepaid shavings will be placed in stalls. Stalls will be available for your use from **3 PM Friday through Sunday evening.** Any animals moving in before that time must make advanced arrangements with show management. Exhibitors are asked to check in at the Show Office to obtain stall assignments before unloading.

Amateur Exhibitors/Leased Horses/Ponies/Youth Exhibitors: All exhibitors must have an Amateur Card to show in an Amateur class. Cards may be purchased from the ASPC/AMHR office or from the Show Steward. **Current owner/lessee name must be shown on the pony/horse registration certificate to show in an Amateur class.** A copy of the lease application/agreement is **not** acceptable. Youth exhibitors do not need a Youth Membership Card to show, but must have a Youth membership card to receive points, placings or awards from ASPC/AMHR. Cards are free but must be applied for annually from the ASPC/AMHR office or from the Show Steward. Helmets are required for all Youth Roadster, all mounted classes and must be ASTM/SEI certified.

Class Description for Class #403 – ASPR Amateur Showmanship (non-rated):

- Exhibitors are to enter the ring at the trot, single file on the rail and then line-up at center ring.
- Exhibitor is to show his/her pony to the presiding (call) Judge only. Pony is to be posed, parked out but not excessively stretched. Pony should have ears up and be alert. As the Judge walks around the pony, the exhibitor is to move right and left around the pony's head to allow the Judge a clear view of the animal.
- At the Ringmaster's or Judge's direction, the exhibitor is to move the pony to the rail at a flat walk, in a straight line. Exhibitor to work pony in both directions on the rail, at a collected show trot, then return to line-up and set up the pony as before.
- Emphasis to be placed on presentation of pony, responsiveness of handler to pony, constant attention to pony, with adjustment to position of handler to give the Judge a clear view of entry.
- Showing to continue until the Judge's card is turned in.
- Required attire: slacks, white short or long-sleeved shirt, tie and gloves. Men are required to wear hats. Vest or jackets are encouraged but are optional.
- Only mares or geldings 1 year or older are to be shown in showmanship and are to be shown in a bridle or show halter.
- There are to be no patterns or pivots as required in other divisions. There is no penalty for touching the animal as needed for optimum showing.
- Judging is to be 10% on attire, 40% on line-up and 50% on rail work considering both the pony's AND the handler's performance

Class Descriptions

Non-Rated Classes

Miniature Horse Halter, Any Age Any Sex – 38” & Under (non-rated)*

- Horses to be shown in halter at a walk and trot. The Judge must ask for the horse to walk past them and then trot away. The Judge must also ask for the horse to trot away and make an L turn to enable the Judge to view the movement of the horse from the side.
- The Miniature Horse is to be shown to its best advantage. It is preferred that the horse stand square. The Judge at his or her discretion may ask to have the horse stand square, which means all four feet are flat on the ground and at least one front and one rear cannon bone perpendicular to the ground.
- Horses may be clipped or shown in full coat.
- Horses may be shown with or without polished hooves.
- Horses must be serviceably sound, in good condition, and well-groomed. Transmissible weakness and unsoundness to be penalized.
- No whips and/or crops are allowed in halter classes.
- In halter division any type halter is permissible.
- Horses shall show with full manes and tails, (no roach). Thinning, pulling, shortening etc., of a mane and tail is permissible. The mane and tail length shall be left to the decision of the exhibitor.
- Changing the coat color of a horse is not permitted but highlighting the mane and tail, eyes, ears, muzzle, etc., is permissible.
- A foal shall not be allowed in the show ring when his/her dam is being exhibited.

Pony Halter, Any Age Any Sex – 46” & Under (non-rated)**

- The Pony halter entry should be a classy pony that is bright and alert with a smart way of going. The pony/entry should possess all of the attributes of quality set forth in the ASPC Standard of Perfection, with as few faults as possible and free of any disqualifying characteristics.
- Ponies to be shown in halter at a walk and trot. The Judge must ask for the horse to walk past them and then trot away. The Judge must also ask for the horse to trot away and make an L turn to enable the Judge to view the movement of the horse from the side.
- The Pony is to be shown to its best advantage. It is preferred that the pony stand square. The Judge at his or her discretion may ask to have the pony stand square, which means all four feet are flat on the ground and at least one front and one rear cannon bone perpendicular to the ground.
- Ponies may be clipped or shown in full coat.
- Ponies may be shown with or without polished hooves.
- Ponies must be serviceably sound, in good condition, and well-groomed. Transmissible weakness and unsoundness to be penalized.
- No whips and/or crops are allowed in halter classes.
- In halter division any type halter is permissible.
- Ponies shall show with full manes and tails, (no roach). Thinning, pulling, shortening etc., of a mane and tail is permissible. The mane and tail length shall be left to the decision of the exhibitor.
- Changing the coat color of a horse is not permitted but highlighting the mane and tail, eyes, ears, muzzle, etc., is permissible.
- A foal shall not be allowed in the show ring when his/her dam is being exhibited.

Miniature Horse Halter Obstacle – 38” & Under (non-rated)*

- The obstacle course must be posted at the Show Office not less than two (2) hours prior to the class. All obstacles must be numbered in order of sequence. The course designer may not exhibit in the obstacle class.
- The exhibitor must attempt to have a clean round. When there is more than one clean round in a class, Judges should evaluate the willingness and the responsiveness of the horse as well as the way in which the handler and the horse interact.
- A horse can only be shown by one exhibitor per class. A handler may show more than one entry in a class.
- Horse to be shown in halter or bridle with appropriate lead, chain on lead permitted under the chin of the horse.
- Horse to be penalized for any unnecessary delay or excessive time at an object. Judge(s) can advance an exhibitor to the next obstacle if a horse is taking excessive time at an obstacle. Maximum time of sixty (60) seconds per obstacle. Refusals of three (3) obstacles shall be cause for disqualification.
- The course designer, Judge(s) and Steward shall walk the course with the exhibitors prior to the class. Judge or Steward has the right to alter the course for safety.
- Suggested Obstacles
 - Over: bridge, tarp, water, jump
 - Pattern: serpentine, figure 8, or cloverleaf at requested gaits
 - Daily Chores: gate, put on and remove equipment (blanket, raincoat, saddle, etc.), mailbox open and close, pick up an object (letter, bucket, umbrella, flag, etc.) and place it at a designated location, side pass over pole, back through poles.

- Ground Tie: stand pony inside a circle and walk around the pony.
- Off course will result in elimination from the class and no points, ribbons or awards will be presented.
- Off course is defined as:
 - Skipping an obstacle unless directed by Judge.
 - Negotiating obstacles in the wrong sequence.
 - Horse leaving the obstacle course.
- No physically moving, or coercing the horse by touching. It is to be the Judge's discretion to disqualify.

Pony Halter Obstacle – 46" & Under (non-rated)**

- The obstacle course must be posted at the Show Office not less than two (2) hours prior to the class. All obstacles must be numbered in order of sequence. The course designer may not exhibit in the obstacle class.
- The exhibitor must attempt to have a clean round. When there is more than one clean round in a class, Judges should evaluate the willingness and the responsiveness of the pony as well as the way in which the handler and the pony interact.
- A pony can only be shown by one exhibitor per class. A handler may show more than one entry in a class.
- Pony to be shown in halter or bridle with appropriate lead, chain on lead permitted under the chin of the pony.
- Pony to be penalized for any unnecessary delay or excessive time at an object. Judge(s) can advance an exhibitor to the next obstacle if a pony is taking excessive time at an obstacle. Maximum time of sixty (60) seconds per obstacle. Refusals of three (3) obstacles shall be cause for disqualification.
- The course designer, Judge(s) and Steward shall walk the course with the exhibitors prior to the class. Judge or Steward has the right to alter the course for safety.
- Suggested Obstacles
 - Over: bridge, tarp, water, jump
 - Pattern: serpentine, figure 8, or cloverleaf at requested gaits
 - Daily Chores: gate, put on and remove equipment (blanket, raincoat, saddle, etc.), mailbox open and close, pick up an object (letter, bucket, umbrella, flag, etc.) and place it at a designated location, side pass over pole, back through poles.
 - Ground Tie: stand pony inside a circle and walk around the pony.
- Off course will result in elimination from the class and no points, ribbons or awards will be presented.
- Off course is defined as:
 - Skipping an obstacle unless directed by Judge.
 - Negotiating obstacles in the wrong sequence.
 - Pony leaving the obstacle course.
- No physically moving, or coercing the pony by touching. It is to be the Judge's discretion to disqualify.

PMC Liberty (non-rated)

- Liberty is demonstrating the natural beauty of the miniature horse/pony. Horse/ponies are to be judged on style, grace, animation, gaits, presence, and ease of catching. The liberty horse/pony is expected to perform at both a canter and a trot.
- It is the Steward's responsibility to time Liberty classes and to be in possession of a stopwatch. The Steward should be in the same location as the Judge(s) to adjudicate the class. Timing will begin when the halter is dropped, not when the music starts, and the show announcer will announce TIME when the 1½ minutes performance time has ended to signal the exhibitor that they can begin the catch. Continue to time the catch. When the 2 minute catch time has elapsed, the show announcer will announce TIME to signal the end of the catch if the animal has not been caught. If the catch is not completed in the 2 minute allotted time frame, the exhibitor is disqualified.
- Only the exhibitor and one assistant will be allowed in the arena with horse/pony. Whips and shaker bottles are allowed, but touching the horse/pony with aids or hands will result in disqualification.
- Only the exhibitor can touch the horse/pony during the catch. The horse/pony must be caught and haltered by the exhibitor only within 2 minutes or be disqualified. The assistant may not touch the horse/pony at any time. There will be "No Baiting" (no use of hay, grain, clickers, etc.) of Liberty horse/ponies during the catch or horse/pony will be disqualified.
- Music is required.
- No deliberate interference with the horse/pony from outside the ring. Announcement is to be made prior to the class to specify that no outside assistance is allowed.
- All horse/ponies entered in the Liberty class must be at least one year old.
- Exhibitor and assistant should wear appropriate, tasteful attire. A safe costume or theme outfit is allowed for exhibitor and assistant only. The horse/pony must be shown natural, no costume, no glitter, no ribbons.
- If the entered horse/pony falls during its performance the entry is disqualified.
- Entry will be disqualified if horse/pony leaves the ring during competition or catch time.

ASPR Amateur Showmanship (non-rated)

- Exhibitors are to enter the ring at the trot, single file on the rail and then line-up at center ring.
- Exhibitor is to show his/her pony to the presiding (call) Judge only. Pony is to be posed, parked out but not excessively stretched. Pony should have ears up and be alert. As the Judge walks around the pony, the exhibitor is to move right and left around the pony's head to allow the Judge a clear view of the animal.
- At the Ringmaster's or Judge's direction, the exhibitor is to move the pony to the rail at a flat walk, in a straight line. Exhibitor to work pony in both directions on the rail, at a collected show trot, then return to line-up and set up the pony as before.
- Emphasis to be placed on presentation of pony, responsiveness of handler to pony, constant attention to pony, with adjustment to position of handler to give the Judge a clear view of entry.
- Showing to continue until the Judge's card is turned in.
- Required attire: slacks, white short or long-sleeved shirt, tie and gloves. Men are required to wear hats. Vest or jackets are encouraged but are optional.
- Only mares or geldings 1 year or older are to be shown in showmanship and are to be shown in a bridle or show halter.
- There are to be no patterns or pivots as required in other divisions. There is no penalty for touching the animal as needed for optimum showing.
- Judging is to be 10% on attire, 40% on line-up and 50% on rail work considering both the pony's AND the handler's performance.
